## DAY TOUR ITINERARY (subject to change)

### 1 KOTA KINABALU – ARRIVAL – NABALU MARKET – KUNDASANG (Dinner)

Arrived at Kota Kinabalu Airport, meet by local guide and take a scenic 2 hours' drive to **Kinabalu Park**. En-route a brief stop at **Nabalu Market**. Nabalu is a place where the local natives gather to sell local products. Proceed to **Kundasang**. Dinner at local Restaurant



### 2 PARK HQ. – TIMPOHON GATE – ASCENT MT. KINABALU - LABAN RATA (Breakfast/Packed Lunch/Dinner)

Transfer to **Kinabalu Park** and collect your packed lunch. Proceed to the Park HQ to register for the climb, meet your assigned mountain guide and apply for your ID TAG (Remember to wear your ID TAG at all times). Transferred to starting point – **Timpohon Gate** – where your journey and quest to the summit of Borneo's highest mountain begins! The climb will take approximately 4-5 hours. Arrive and check into one of the assorted Laban Rata huts @3272m (non-heated dormitory beds) in the late afternoon. Buffet Dinner at Laban Rata restaurant.



### 3 LOW'S PEAK / DESCENT MT. KINABALU – KOTA KINABALU (Supper / Breakfast / Lunch)

0200hrs - Wake up for early supper and depart for continuation of journey towards the summit of **Mount Kinabalu**. The journey up to the Low's peak @ 4,095m will test your fitness and determination. Depending on speed of trekking, you might be able to experience the glorious sunrise over the majestic Mt. Kinabalu if weather permits.  
0700hrs - Descend back to Laban Rata for late breakfast and check out. Trek down to Timpohon Gate for transfer back to the Kinabalu Park Headquarters. Congratulations! You can now collect your Certificate of Achievement! Buffet Lunch will be served at the Balsam restaurant in Kinabalu Park.  
1400hrs - Transfer back to Kota Kinabalu and check in hotel. The rest of the day at leisure.

*Note: Last pick up from Kinabalu Park to Kota Kinabalu is 1500hrs*



### 4 KOTA KINABALU – DEPARTURE (Breakfast)

Depart Kota Kinabalu, transfer to the airport.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

### Things You Should Prepare For Mountain Climb

Waterproof backpack to store your items, Trekking or running shoe with good grip, arm clothing/Long sleeves shirt/Hiking pants, Jacket/Wind breaker, Extra clothing and socks, Small towel, Hand gloves and winter hat, Disposable raincoats, Head torch, Personal toiletries, Refillable water bottle (0.5 - 1 Litre), High energy food such as chocolates, nuts, biscuits, sweets, energy bars, Your extra luggage can be stored at Kinabalu Park HQ at a nominal fee of MYR 10-12 per piece prior climb.

### Things You Wish To Bring

Medication such as headache tablets or altitude sickness tablets, Tissue paper / Toilet roll, Sun block lotion, lip gloss, plasters, Insect repellent / Mosquito Oil, Camera with water proof bag, Sandals / Slippers, Plastic bags

### Identity Card or Passport

1. In compliance with the Personal Data Protection Act 2010 (PDPA), SSL requires all guests to produce their identity cards or valid passports upon check-in. Non-Malaysian nationalities must produce their valid **international passports** upon check-in.
2. To facilitate a smoother check-in process for your group, please provide us with a **copy of your guests' identity cards or valid passports at least 7 working days prior to their arrival** for us to enter guests' details into our system. The original documents will be required to be presented at the registration desk for verification purposes against the data in our system.
3. A similar requirement applies to Sabah Parks, ie agents are required to submit the climbers' form with a copy of their identity cards or valid passports.

### Hotel Check-in & Check-out Time

- ❖ Climbers who reached Timpohon Gate after 1600hrs, a fee of RM 15.00 per hour/guide is chargeable and to be paid directly to the mountain guide on the spot.
- ❖ Laban Lata
  - Check in time at Laban Rata is 1300hrs and check out time is 1030hrs the following day
  - An additional charge of RM 100.00 per hour will be imposed for any check out later than 1030hrs
  - Water at Laban Rata is not treated. For safe drinking water, bottled water is available for sale at Laban Rata shop.

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following:-

### Package Price

Quoted and payment in Ringgit Malaysia (RM). Validity of prices is seasonal and subject to change without prior notice. Child rates are applicable when child are occupying a room with at least two adult.

### Deposit & Payment

A 30% non-refundable deposit is required within 3 days upon booking is made (subject to change based on travel dates). Receipt for deposit is valid for three (3) months from the date of issued. The deposit forms part of your final payment. Balance (final payment) must be made 45 days prior to departure (subject to confirmation of tour package). Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of your reservations and forfeiture of your deposit.

### Accommodation

Bedding various from hotel to hotel, but the following usually apply:-

Single – consist 1 Queen Bed

Double – consist 1 Queen/King Bed

Twin – consist 2 Single Beds

Triple – consist 1 Double Bed & 1 rollaway bed / 3 Single beds

If a rollaway bed is required, extra charge applies. Most hotels will not put more than one rollaway in a room. Baby cots can be requested in advance and if extra charge applies, passenger must pay directly to hotel.

### Amendment Charges

An administrative fee of RM100 will be charged for each subsequent amendment made after the confirmation. Any other cost arising from the amendment will be borne by the passenger. No amendment can be made within 30days prior to departure. A change on the entire booking is considered as a cancellation and is subject to cancellation charges.

### Cancellation Charges
