DAY	TOUR ITINERARY (Subject to change)
1	ATHENS – ARRIVAL Upon arrival at Athens airport, meet and transfer to hotel for check in. The rest of the day at leisure.
2	ATHENS (BREAKFAST) Pick up from hotel and proceed for guided Athens sightseeing tour. Pass by the Panathenaic Stadium , the Temple of Olympian Zeus , Hadrian’s Arch , the Parliament and the memorial of the Unknown Soldier , the Academy , the University the National Library and the Constitution Square (Syntagma). Your tour will be followed by a visit to Acropolis , the eternal symbol of democracy, education and inspiration. Your tour will end with the visit to the impressive Acropolis Museum . Afternoon at leisure.
3	ATHENS – EPIDAUROS – NAUPLION – MYCENAE – OLYMPIA (BREAKFAST/DINNER) First stop at the Canal of Corinth , A narrow man-made shipping Canal. Next stop to the Ancient theatre of Epidaurus , world known for its acoustics. Short visit in the town of Nafplion , a seaport town and last stop in the ancient city of Mycenae to visit the Archeological Site and the Tomb of Agamemnon . Departure to Olympia.
4	OLYMPIA - DELPHI (BREAKFAST/DINNER) Morning visit to the Archaeological Site with the Sanctuary of Olympian Zeus , the Ancient Stadium , and the Archaeological Museum . We will continue our drive, traveling through the plains of Eliad and Achaia until we reach the magnificent bridge crossing the Corinthian Bay from Rion to Antirion . Passing by the picturesque towns of Nafpactos (Lepanto) and Itea before arrive in Delphi .
5	DELPHI – KALAMBAKA (BREAKFAST/DINNER) Visit the Castalia Spring and the main archaeological site the Temple of Apollo, the Treasury of the Athenians, the Theatre, the Stadium and the Museum with the famous statue of Antinoos and the unique bronze statue of the Charioteer. Departure to Kalambaka.
6	KALAMBAKA – METEORA – ATHENS (BREAKFAST) Depart for Meteora , The UNESCO World Heritage site is home to more than 20 rock monasteries , either perched precariously on top of Meteora’s towering sandstone cliffs or built into the cliffs themselves inside naturally formed caves. Originally lived in by 11th-century hermits, the monasteries later became safe havens for monks fleeing bloodshed when the Roman Empire began to fall. Return to Athens early in the evening.
7	ATHENS – SANTORINI (by Ferry) (BREAKFAST) Transfer to the Piraeus port to embark the ferry to Santorini (07:25 – 14:50hrs) Upon arrival, transfer to hotel for check in. Rest of the day at leisure.
8	SANTORINI (BREAKFAST) Whole day at leisure. Walk in the paths of Fira (capital of Santorini), the picturesque capital of Santorini; perched high up on the edge of the Caldera and enjoy the views of the volcano, ocean, white-washed buildings, and blue domed churches. Explore Oia , Firotstefani and Imerovigli on your own and relax while seeing the most beautiful sunset in the world, drinking some famous traditional wine.
9	SANTORINI – ATHENS (BREAKFAST) Morning at leisure. Transfer to the port to embark the ferry to Piraeus port. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel in Athens.
10	ATHENS – DEPARTURE (BREAKFAST) Depart Athens, transfer to airport.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Package Price

Accommodation
